Officials (including Adjudicators, Scrutineers, Registrars, Masters of Ceremonies, Music Directors and Organizers) are not allowed to give coaching lessons, on or off the premises, during the entire period of time eommencing at 12:00 a.m. on the day of the first competitive session and concluding with the end of the last session of their officiating contract for the event. Once an official begins to work for an event their contract may not be suspended so that they may give coaching lessons. This does not apply to Lectures or Seminars scheduled by the organizer and open to any interested parties.

a. <u>Additionally, no official may give coaching lessons at the same venue where the event is held once the competition begins until the time that the competition ends, regardless of the start or end of their particular officiating contract.</u>

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS - AMATEUR COMPETITORS

UNITED STATES NATIONAL AMATEUR BALLROOM CHAMPIONSHIPS: Properly registered Amateur Competitors are eligible to dance in any closed championship of the United States Ballroom Championships if they fulfill one of the following criteria:

- a. Both members of the partnership are United States citizens <u>or United States Resident Aliens</u> (<u>Green Card holders</u>), and neither member of the partnership has been nominated by a national organization to represent another country in the previous 12 months.
- b. One half of the partnership is a United States citizen <u>or United States Resident Alien (Green Card holder)</u>, and neither member of the partnership has been nominated by a national organization to represent another country in the previous 12 months, and the half of the partnership that is not a U.S. citizen <u>or United States Resident Alien (Green Card holder)</u> has resided in the USA for the previous 6 months.
- (1) Any Non-U.S. citizen who has resided in the United States of America for less than the previous twelve months may be required to submit a photo copy of their passport showing the date they entered the USA before their entry into a closed United States National Championship may be accepted.
- c. Both members of the partnership are non-United States citizens <u>and non-United States Resident Aliens (Green Card holders)</u>, but both members of the partnership have resided in the USA for the previous 6 months, and neither member of the partnership has been nominated by a national organization to represent another country in the previous 12 months.

The Pro/Am student winner of any Closed Multi-Dance or Rising Star Multi-Dance event of three dances or more, in which a semifinal is held <u>at any Championship event</u>, is ineligible to compete in the same Multi-Dance Level, Style, and Age category at that event in following years at that same event. Organizers may enforce more stringent requirements, provided it is outlined in their Rules and Regulations and included on entry forms.

Reason: Organizers at all events (Competitions & Championships) are not tracking the winners. Does the onus fall upon the organizer or the registrar?? We feel this could/should be a Championship rule/restriction. Can Premier or Compmgr software assist in this.

This avoids the same student from winning a championship year after year (same age/style/level). Time to move on to the next level or Open categories.

Reason: so all members have an organization they can go to for questions, help, training, exams, and also have representation on the Council.

Note: would need to specify an effective date, and also add a provision to allow registration for a period of time before membership in good standing with a Member Organization would be required for new professional registrants.

The organizers of this event have one request:

1) a slight change to their date formula to be the Sunday prior to the Martin Luther King holiday. The MLK holiday is the third Monday in January.
