

- (1) Skirts
  - (a) Plain or pleated with minimum 1 to maximum 3 half circles, including godets and/or extra panels. One plain simple underskirt allowed which is no larger or longer than top layer, and is the same or similar color as the outer skirt.
  - (b) No godets or extra panels may be inserted into the skirt
  - (c) No uneven hem lines, frills, splits, openings, lace, ruffles, or sequins.
  - (d) Horsehair/Crinoline may be used only inside the hem of the skirt. as part of the construction but not as a trim.
  - (e) Ribbon on the skirt is acceptable, but no other trim is allowed.
- (2) Bodice
  - (a) Shoulderless bodices are not allowed.
- (3) Materials
  - (a) Any use of <u>mesh</u>, <u>lace</u>, <u>or any color coordinated</u> 'see-through' fabric must be lined from <u>the</u> waist to the top of the bust line, <u>as well as a corresponding height in the back shoulder</u>. <u>When mesh</u>, <u>lace</u>, <u>or any "see-through" fabric is used on the for use on arms no lining is needed.</u>
  - (b) Lace and/or burnout Burnout (also called Devoré), or similar fabric, must be lined with a fabric of the same color. is not allowed. Lycra, spandex, polyester, plain velvet, satin or jersey is encouraged.

#### **Recommendation** #1

Add the Left side same foot grapevine in Silver Smooth. This would be the lone exception to same foot in left side by side position in the Silver level. It would be allowed in Foxtrot ONLY and limited to 4 beats with no syncopations. The reason for this is that a number of Professionals have requested this thru the Competitor's Commission, and it seems a reasonable accommodation to make. Additionally, this element is currently being danced in Silver extensively.

#### **Recommendation** #2

Remove the nightclub section.

Reason: These dances do not need to be invigilated. There currently is no consensus of names or patterns for Bronze, Silver and Gold closed material. By definition these dances are informal and should stay that way.

#### **Recommendation** #3

Approve the new Bronze, Silver, & Gold American Style Rhythm Restrictions. To become Effective January 20, 2020 – (This effective date gives all organizations time to share and get reaction from their members before the January 2020 meeting.)

Currently a Local One-Day Event or Multi-Day Competition can permanently box in or restrict a Championship to date and/or location. Whereas, if a Championship were to relinquish its Championship status, they could then be allowed to change permanently. Why should a Championship have to do this?

- a. Competitors whose figures are determined by the Invigilator (or Chairman of Adjudicators) not to be within the prescribed level shall be warned and penalized as follows:
  - (1) Early round violation A warning from the Chairman of Adjudicators or the Invigilator.
  - (2) Subsequent round repeated violation All recalls or marks for that dance erased (at the discretion of the Chairman of Adjudicators).
  - (3) Final round violation:
    - (a) Where no previous infraction has been made, marked down one place in that dance.
    - (b) When a competitor has already been warned and repeats the same
